Highlights of 2008

The **Gordon Cooper** Branch created a designated Teen Area and expanded teen programming. One Book, One Town programs brought all the Carbondale Middle Schools together to read Colorado author Laura Reseau's book <u>What the</u> <u>Moon Saw</u> and the adult program welcomed author Aryn Kyle to talk about her book <u>God of Animals</u>.

The **Glenwood Springs** Branch started the children's Summer Reading Program with a capacity crowd of 297 people at the first performance. A "tween" advisory group and book club for ages 9 - 12 were formed in addition to the existing teen advisory group and teen book club (which now specifically target older teens age 13 - 18). All four groups continue to grow.

The **New Castle** Branch hosted the 1st Annual End of Summer Party in Burning Mountain Park for the residents of the Town of New Castle. The Last Minute String Band performed while everyone enjoyed free ice cream and a lovely warm summer evening.

The **Silt Branch** experienced changes in staff when Janine Rose moved to Assistant Director of Public Services and Dan Mickelson became the new Branch Manager. The shelves in the non-fiction area were extended and work has been done to maximize other spaces throughout the library for an ever-growing collection of materials. The **Rifle Branch** had a 36.4% increase in circulation of print materials. The applications for library cards more than doubled, going from 1012 in 2007 to 2128 in 2008. Rifle concentrated on



increasing adult programming and hosted twelve programs (up from two the year before).

The **Parachute Branch** underwent an extreme make-over featuring three new staff members, an expanded teen

book area, revitalized children's programs, an adult-teen reading club and record-breaking checkouts up 36.5% from 2007!

The **Library District** experienced a continued increase in patronage which is evidenced in the 96% increase (since 2007) in people who have library cards. The District also began working on

construction projects to remodel the A Parachute Branch and build a new Rifle Branch in 2010. achieve dream soar




